

THE MARK HENRY CAIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

With the support of a generous endowment made by a private donor, the School is able to offer an annual scholarship of \$10,000 in commemoration of Mark Henry Cain, an artist trained at Glasgow School of Art who relocated to Sydney in 1937. The Mark Henry Cain Memorial Scholarship supports a student to travel and study for a period of 6-8 weeks in the UK.

Applications close Monday 13 November 2023.

The successful applicant is expected to travel to the UK in 2024. Award Announcement: **Thursday 30 November 2023.**

Eligibility

The scholarship is open to NAS students progressing from the Bachelor of Fine Art program to the Master of Fine Art program in 2024.

Criteria

Applications are assessed against the following criteria:

- Record of academic achievement and quality of work produced at BFA level.
- Quality of Master of Fine Art studio project proposal.
- Proposal for travel, research and/or study during 6-8 week period in the UK, including a detailed itinerary of travel, galleries and museums you plan to visit and artists work you plan to investigate. The travel proposal must demonstrate the benefit of this scholarship to your artistic and academic development.

Timing

It is expected that the successful applicant will take their travel outside of NAS academic semesters and in conjunction with the Postgraduate Coordinator. It is expected that the successful applicant will take up the scholarship in the summer break following the completion of MFA1 in November 2024.
